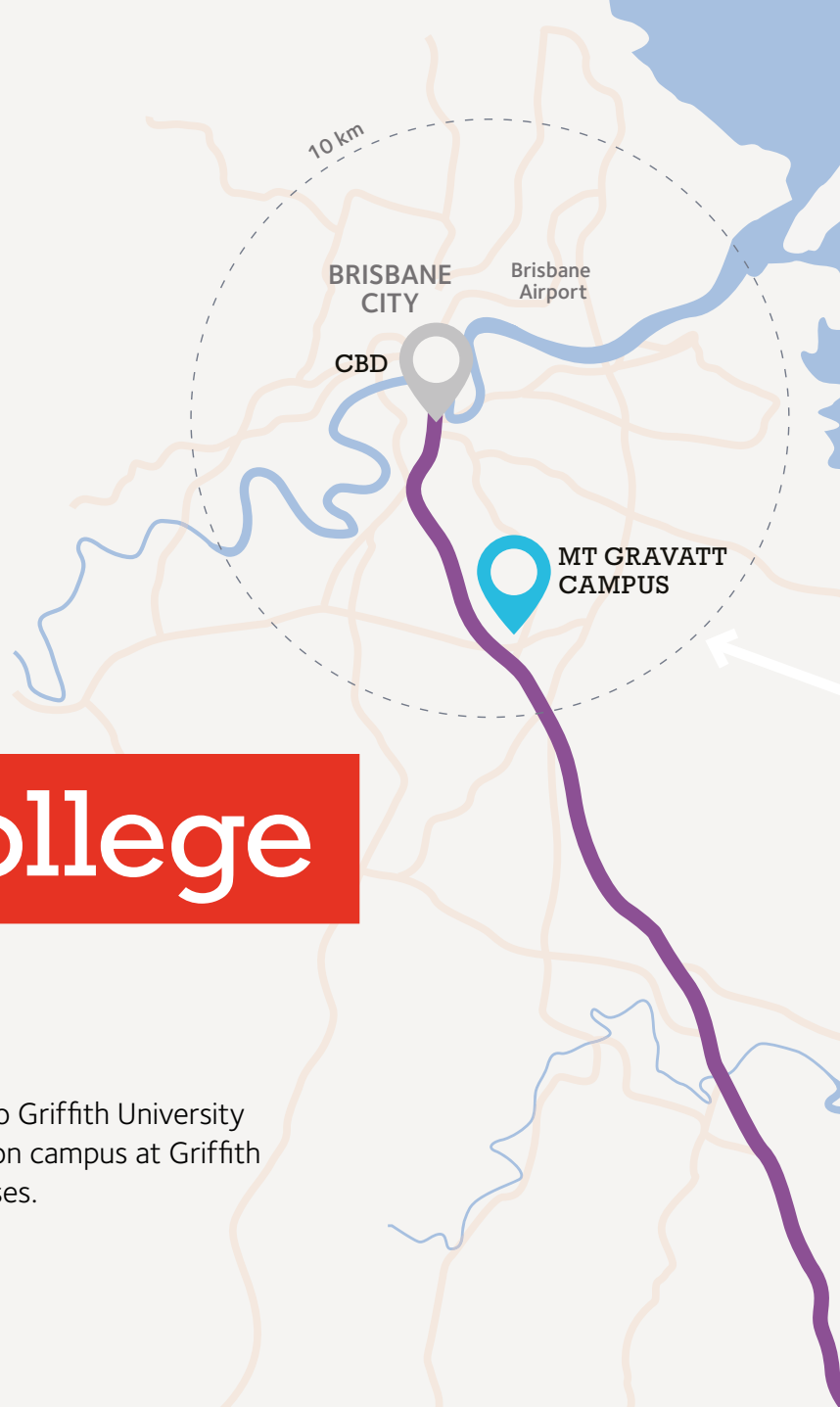

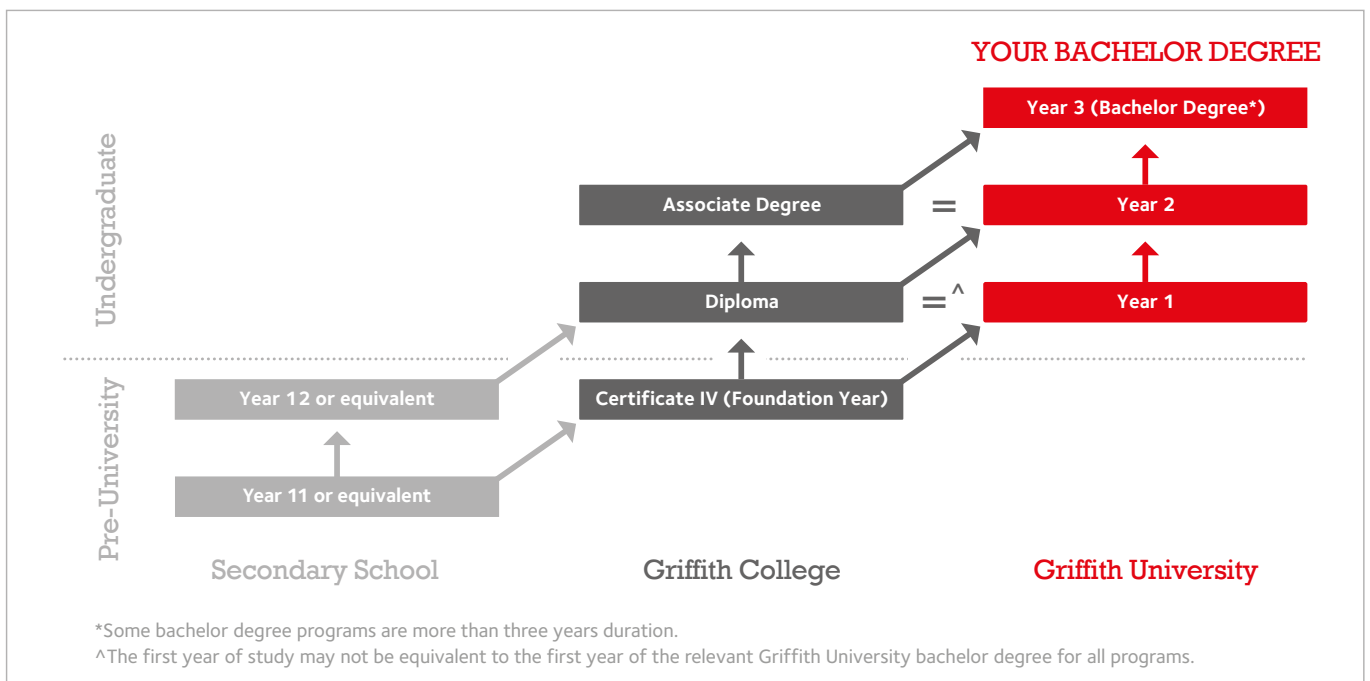

Criminology is the study of the complex issues of crime and criminal justice. Criminologists work in federal and state justice agencies such as research and statistics institutes, police departments and courts. Correctional authorities also employ criminologists as researchers, assessors and policy advisors, while others might work in private practice providing consulting services for law reform, justice, forensic psychology, behavioural science or crime statistics.
